## REVIEW VOCABULARY

### Bandwidth

The amount of data that can travel from one place to another within a certain amount of time.

### Card Sorting

Organizing all the categories and subcategories of a website with index cards and trying to decide which parts should go on which pages.

### Collaboration

Working with a team of people to achieve a common goal.

### Encryption

Converting data from a readable form to an unreadable form known as ciphertext.

### HTML Comments

When a designer wishes to leave a comment in their source code, but doesn't wish for that comment to show up on the page, they can write `<!-- My Comment -->`.

### Mind Mapping

This comes before any format or design is attempted. Mind mapping is a graphic map of possible pages that will help to give a website everything it needs.

### Persona

A representation of what the designer believes his/her audience will be (students, historians, etc).
