REVIEW VOCABULARY

Content Management System

These are programs like WordPress, Weebly, or Drupal that usually have pre-made templates which a designer can modify for their websites without being an expert in HTML, CSS, or JS.

FNC

This refers to the File Naming Convention (or the rule about how to name files/folders). The standard rule for naming files are: (1) no space, (2) use underscores for spaces, (3) if you must capitalize, then just the beginning of words—avoid ALL CAPS, and (4) no commas or periods.

ICANN

The Internet Corporation for Assigning Names and Numbers takes responsibility for assigning Domain Names to different IP numbers that belong to different computers. Since the files/folders of a website belong to a computer IP address, the domain name replaces the IP and ICANN is the group that makes this possible.

XML

XML stands for Extensible Markup Language and it's VERY similar to HTML. The difference is that XML are tags/elements that don't actually DO anything. For example, an HTML code might have `<info>Phone Number</info>`, but the "info" tag is only useful to the designer because it's not a REAL tag. And it won't change the way "Phone Number" looks on the page.
