REVIEW VOCABULARY

File Transfer Protocol

A set of rules that allows files to be exchanged (transferred) from one computer to another.

Secure Shell (SSH)

A protocol used to verify the identity of the computer making a remote connection, then encrypt the data being moved. A Secure Shell is often used when someone remotely controls a computer over a network and sends data to that computer from a different location. In which case, the data would be encrypted.

Secure Sockets Layer (SSL)

A protocol used to encrypt data sent between a web browser and a web server. For example, when you see a website that begins with `https`, like your class website, this means that any data someone enters into that site (passwords, credit card numbers, etc) is encrypted and secured. SSL is also known as Transport Layer Security, or TLS.

Streaming

When a multimedia file is constantly being received by the user (videos or audios in play).

Web Host or Server

A service computer (server) used for holding all the files/folders of a website domain.
